BLACK TEA

From Yunnan to Ceylon and Assam, black teas have strength and structure, with a rich and often malty taste offering a unique intensity of flavour.

ASSAM BREAKFAST

Assam, India ~ Malty, Honey, Raisin

Satisfying and robust second flush leaves with honeyed malt richness selected from

Assam's foremost gardens, showcasing the true character of the region.

EARL GREY

Assam, India ~ Malty, Wild Honey, Bergamot

Masterfully blended by JING™ for the perfect balance of flavour. A touch of natural bergamot extract tempers the inherent richness of the tea for supreme texture and flavour.

ORGANIC DARJEELING SECOND FLUSH

Darjeeling, India ~ Grape, Alpine Flowers, Malt

CEYLON DECAFFEINATED

CHAI

RED DRAGON

Yunnan, China ~ Lychee, Ginger, Milk Chocolate

A unique and exceptional tea, using a tea cultivar traditionally used for oolong. This gives the tea a syrupy, rich texture, fruity aroma and an enticing flavour of dark berries, ginger, caramel and chocolate.

WHITE TEA

ORGANIC WHITE PEONY

Nayun Garden, China ~ Rose, Honey, Gooseberry

Produced by Mr. Yang Jian in a biodiverse garden in Yunnan's densely forested and remote mountains, this Organic White Peony is perfect for those who like a relaxing infusion.

JASMINE SILVER NEEDLE

Yinpan Garden, Yunnan, China ~ Jasmine, Honeydew, Vanilla

The Jasmine Silver Needle tea is composed of perfect, downy buds from China's Yunnan province that are freshly picked in spring then simply dried. Delicate and soothing, this tea is the perfect partner for a moment of calm.

GREEN TEA

Crafted by masters with generations of knowledge, green teas taste vegetal and fresh, with a natural spring-sweetness and a satisfying, silky texture.

ORGANIC JADE SWORD

Jingshan Garden, China ~ Flora, Edamame, Cut Grass

A grassy, spring-flower aroma emanates from a beautifully bright green infusion that is full of sweet, succulent flavour.

ORGANIC SENCHA

Shizuoka, Japan ~ Dashi, Sweetcorn, Sea Salt

Japan's most famous green tea. This spring-picked, steamed green tea is refreshingly complex and sappy with deep, savoury umami and intense vegetal sweetness in a concentrated, smooth infusion.

ORGANIC GENMAICHA

Shizuoka, Japan ~ Popcorn, Sesame, Steamed Greens

The Japanese name Genmaicha literally translates to 'brown rice and tea', referring to the addition of white popped rice kernels to a green tea base - 50% rice, 50% tea.

OOLONG TEA

Oolong teas offer wonderfully complex profiles with diverse flavours and aromas, crafted by masters in Taiwan and China.

ALI SHAN

(£10 SUPPLEMENT)

Chenjai Garden, Ali Shan, Taiwan ~ Apricot, Cream, Strawberry Leaf

Grown in the lofty heights of Taiwan's most treasured national park, Ali Shan is a Taiwanese oolong tea blended with orange peel and orange oil. It has fresh citrus notes and floral aroma, an ideal alternative to Earl Grey.

YELLOW GOLD

Fujian, China ~ Meadow Grass, Linseed, Syrup

Full-bodied, caramelised biscuit flavour typical of oolong teas, but with the grassy freshness of spring green teas. Hand rolled leaves open on infusion to give a characteristic, yellow-gold liquor with lime green hues.

HERBAL INFUSIONS

Herbal tea infusions are comprised of the highest quality, freshly picked and dried whole herbs, flowers and fruits and are naturally caffeine-free.

PEPPERMINT

Bavaria, Germany ~ Intense, Cool, Refreshing

Picked whole and slowly dried to retain essential oils, colour and flavour. A refreshing, smooth and invigorating infusion.

WHOLE CHAMOMILE

Slavonia, Croatia ~ Hay, Honey, Apple

The name for these daisy-like flowers derives from the Greek word Khamaimelon, which literally means 'earth apple', owing to the fragrant apple scent they release.

LEMONGRASS & GINGER

Thailand, Nigeria ~ Citrus, Ginger, Cut Grass

Bracing and zesty with intensely fresh lemongrass and satisfying warming ginger. An invigorating and spicy infusion that is both warming and uplifting.

BLACKCURRANT, ELDERBERRY & HIBISCUS

Hungary & Germany

A bold infusion with whole blackcurrants, berries and cracked hibiscus shells.

RASPBERRY, ROSE & OSMANTHUS

A soothing, fruity herbal tea with whole raspberry pieces and dried rosebuds.
